 - 4th-5th grade One 90 minute unit per day
- Math (3rd-5th) May 7th, May 8th, May 9th
 - May 7th One 60 minute unit
 - May 8th One 60 minute unit
 - May 9th One 60 minute unit
- Science (5th grade only) May 14th, May 15th
 - Two 45 minute units per day
- Middle School Testing Dates
 - ELA (6th-8th) May 5th, May 6th
 - One 90 minute unit per day
 - Math (6th-8th) May 7th, May 8th
 - May 7th Two 60 minute units
 - May 8th One 60 minute unit
 - Algebra One 90 minute unit per day
 - Science (8th grade only) May 14th, May 15th
 - Two 45 minute units per day
- Make-up Testing Dates May 16th May 23rd
