 - May 10th Two 60 minute units
 - May 11th One 60 minute unit
- Middle School Testing Dates
 - o Science (8th grade only) May 1st and 2nd
 - Two 45 minute units each day
 - o ELA (6th 8th) May 15th, 16th
 - One 90 minute unit per day
 - o Math (6th 8th) May 17th and 18th
 - May 17th Two 60 minute units
 - May 18th One 60 minute unit
 - Algebra One 90 minute unit per day
- Make-up Testing Dates May 30th June 2nd
