

Goal #1: Student Achievement

Promote the academic improvement of all students in ELA and Math through the implementation of our updated curriculum aligned to the 2023 New Jersey Student Learning Standards. Implementation progress and quality will be monitored through frequent classroom walkthroughs in all buildings by our administrative team. By the end of the 2024-25 school year, our goal is an improvement in our Grades 3-8 NJSLA scores by 3% over the 2023-24 scores. The tables below include specific targets for the percentage of students who will meet and exceed grade level expectations for our general population and for our special education and economically disadvantaged subgroups:

Goal #2: Budget
