

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Upper Twp Middle School

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing (did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 1/1/23-3/31/23 we did not do follow up sampling for Radiologicals and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

Below is a list of the contaminant (s) we did not properly test for during this year. How often we are supposed to sample for Radiologicals, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were taken.

We were required to take one sample per year for Radiologicals, we are supposed to take that sample in the 1st quarter of the year. The sample was taken on May 16, 2023. The results were within acceptable levels

What is being done?

There is nothing else to do at this time, we are back on yearly monitoring.
