We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that the Start Strong Fall 2021 testing will be held during the first two weeks of October. These NJSLA tests are online assessments that have been implemented to provide schools and districts the flexibility to address students' needs at the beginning of the school year. These computer-based assessments are aligned to the New Jersey State standards, and students will be assessed on content from the previous grade level. Tests are designed to be brief, with only one 60 minute language arts, and 60 minute math section in grades 4 - 8. There will also be one 60 minute science test for 6th grade only. Parents will receive an Individual Student Report (ISR) for each content in which their child is tested.

 - Tuesday October 5th, 2021

 - 10/6, 10/7, 10/8
- Middle School
 - o Language Arts and Math

 - o Science (6th grade only)
 - Wednesday October 13th, 2021
 - o Make up dates
 - 10/13 (afternoon), 10/14, 10/15

Please be aware that any student, who arrives late to school while the test is being administered, will have to make up that particular test. Students who arrive late will have to wait in the office until testing is over.
