

# Upper Township Preschool Program



Dear Upper Township Families,

The Upper Township School District will be offering a Regular Education **FULL DAY** Preschool Inclusion Program for three and four year old children. The purpose of the program is to provide preschool children with disabilities a regular education experience where they can receive their education with non-disabled peers.

This program is located at the Primary School and consists of approximately ten non-disabled students and five disabled students per class. Children **MUST BE** three years old by 10/1/2017 and **fully toilet trained** to be considered. The program follows the Upper Township School District calendar. There will be tuition of \$5600 for non-disabled students. Transportation is not available. Selection will be by a publicly run lottery. A meeting to discuss the program and answer any questions will be held on Tuesday March 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the Primary School music room.

This full day program will provide all of the students with early learning experiences that will assist them when they enter kindergarten. Our program focuses on the developmental needs of the child and includes appropriate activities to help develop communication, motor, self-help, and behavioral skills. Specials, an opportunity to buy lunch, and nap time is also included.

Application for participation in the lottery can be made in person at the Primary School between March 20<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. No applications will be accepted after March 24, 2017. The office hours are 9:30am-4:00pm.

The public lottery will be held on Tuesday March 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the Primary School music room. A parent/guardian must be present to represent the student at the lottery.
